In pursuance of the recommendation of the Report of the Committee to develop the process for ascertaining the outstanding LF/SUC dues and their recovery, the terms and conditions of the Standard of Procedure of Deduction verification Report (SOP DVR) dated 05.05.2023 are hereby amended to the extant detailed below:
