To address the issues relating to proliferation of Public Wi-Fi Access Points, following amendment/additions are hereby issued in the existing Wi-Fi ACCESS NETWORK INTERFACE (WANI) Framework and Guidelines for Registration with immediate effect:

NA	 New Clause (a) (5): Annexure B: (Under functions of PDO) is inserted as follows: 5. A PDO is allowed to take internet connectivity at a single location for ex: mall, market, shopping complex, bus station etc. and can network up to 100 Access Points to create a single Wi-Fi hotspot.
NA	 New Clause (a) (6): Annexure B: (Under functions of PDO) is inserted as follows: 6. In an Access Point, it is possible to configure SSIDs, one for private use and another for public use. PDOs could use the existing Access Points working at homes or enterprises for establishing the public Wi-Fi hotspots by configuring 2nd SSID and integrating the same with the captive portal of registered PDOA, subject to prior intimation to ISP / TSP.
