Minutes of 2nd meeting of Delhi State Broadband Committee

The second meeting of Delhi State Broadband Committee was held on 16.07.2021 at 3:00 PM under the chairmanship of Chief Secretary, GNCTD through Video Conferencing. The list of participants is annexed herewith as Annexure-I.

2. Secretary (IT) welcomed all the committee members and thereafter Sr. DDG, Head of Delhi LSA, DoT started discussions on agenda items including decisions and present status of all items discussed in the first State Broadband Committee (SBC) meeting held on 19.10.2020 (Copy of PPT at Annexure-II). The details on deliberations/discussions and decisions taken with action plan are as given below:

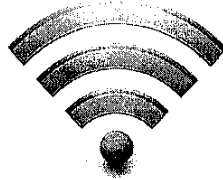

Alignment of Delhi NCT RoW policy with Indian Telegraph Right of Way rules, 2016 (RoW Rules-2016) notified by Central Government.

Decision taken:

Chief Secretary, GNCTD advised to ensure that the GoI rules are followed appropriately and the RoW policy of NCT of Delhi is notified within a month.

Status:

- While efforts have been made by GNCTD for bringing Draft RoW Policy in Jan,2020, followed by Draft RoW Policy prepared by SDMC in Sep,2020,
- VC meeting by ACS UD, GNCTD was held on 02.11.2020 with all stakeholders for early notification.
- Present RoW charges being levied by local bodies in Delhi are quite high and are **not aligned to RoW Rules-2016**.

- While, GNCTD RoW Policy in alignment to RoW Rules- 2016 is yet to be notified, SDMC and North DMC have revised charges of permissions for Cell towers vide Circulars dated 05.01.2021 & 21.01.2021 resp. and are not aligned to RoW Rules-2016.

Additional issues from TAIPA/ COAI

i. Enhancement of fee for permission of cell Tower by SDMC & North DMC:

- South MCD & North MCD have revised the charges (Circular dated 5th Jan & 21st Jan 2021) by passing a resolution in their house.
- The Charges have been increased from Rs 2 lakh per tower for a 5-year block to Rs 1 lakh per tower annually i.e 5 lakh for a 5- year block along with one time charges of Rs 10k per tower and 25% sharing charges.
- This has resulted in reluctance from TSPs/ IPs in applying for new tower permissions. COAI and TAIPA jointly have taken up this matter with the Commissioner, South & North vide letter nos. JCT/ 2021/001 and JCT/ 2021/002 dated 04.02.2021 & 06.02.2021 respectively.

Action Suggested:

Notification of RoW Policy by GNCTD may resolve the issues.

Additional issues from TAIPA/ COAI

ii. Smooth functioning of Online portal launched by SDMC:

- Present issues being faced by industry in SDMC Online Portal are as follows:
 1. Documents to be submitted against each type of tower needs to be aligned with the settlement agreement in the portal.
 2. Ward and zone list need to be updated in North MCD application portal.
