

Proceedings of the 2nd meeting of the State Broad Band Committee held on 27.06.2022 under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to Government of Karnataka.

Hon'ble Chief Secretary welcomed all the officers present in the meeting and started the meeting.

The following instructions were issued after a lengthy discussion on the ROW issues regarding State Broad Band.
